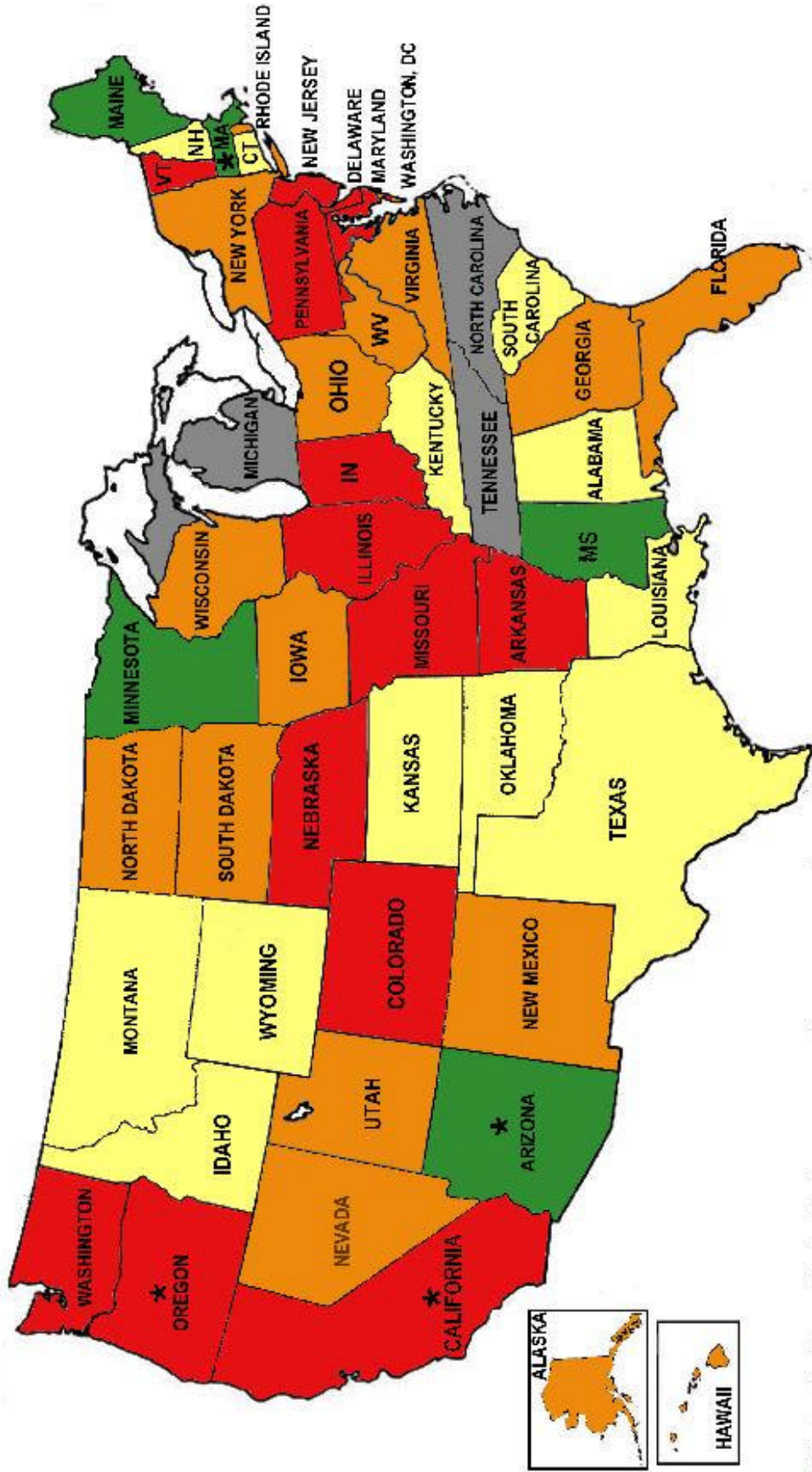


# Funding for Tobacco Prevention from Settlement Dollars



States that have funded tobacco prevention programs at a level that meets the CDC's minimum recommendation.

States that have committed substantial funding for tobacco prevention programs.

States that have committed modest amounts of tobacco settlement money for tobacco prevention programs.

States that have committed minimal amounts of tobacco settlement money for tobacco prevention programs.

States that have committed none of their tobacco settlement money for tobacco prevention programs.

\* Arizona has a comprehensive tobacco prevention program currently funded solely from state tobacco excise taxes. California, Massachusetts and Oregon use funds from their tobacco settlement payments to supplement their current tobacco prevention programs, also funded by state tobacco excise taxes.
